I got my passport last month.



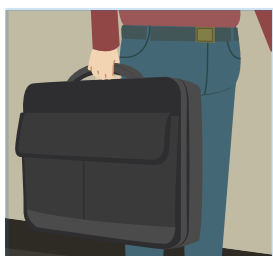
To apply for a visa

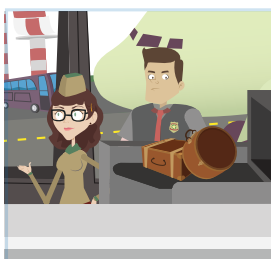

Mind the gap

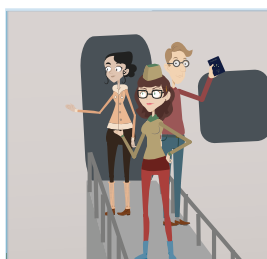
Além do verbo *to book*, que significa reservar, você pode dizer "fazer uma reserva" usando a expressão *to make a reservation*.

Assim, poderíamos dizer: *I'm going to make a reservation at a hotel*, que significa literalmente, "vou fazer uma reserva no hotel".

You always have to go through immigration when you go to a foreign country.



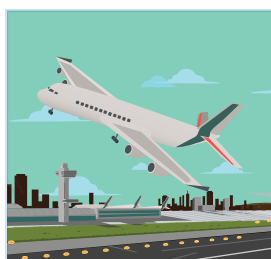
To board the plane

The sign reads: "fasten your seatbelts".



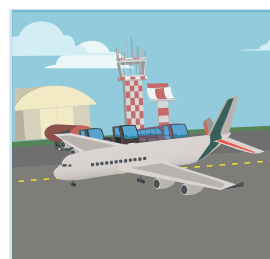
To take off

The plane took off an hour ago.



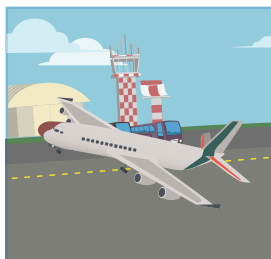
To land

We're going to land in a few minutes.



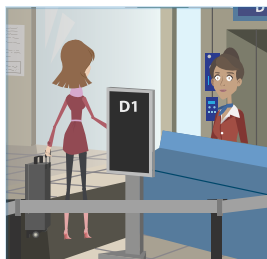
To arrive

The plane arrives in half an hour.



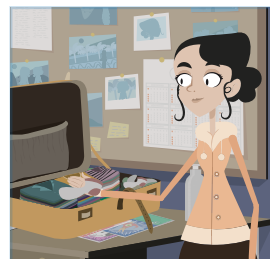
To depart
