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Já os verbos irregulares possuem o participípio passado totalmente diferente da sua forma base e do passado regular. Acompanhe alguns exemplos:

IRREGULAR VERBS

Base form	Simple Past	Past participle
be	was/were	been
buy	bought	bought
eat	ate	eaten
see	saw	seen

A forma negativa do *Present Perfect Simple* é construída acrescentando a partícula **not** ao verbo auxiliar *have* - *has*. Neste caso, é possível utilizar a forma contraída *haven't* ou *hasn't*. Observe que o *main verb* continua no passado particípio:

Subject	Auxiliary + not	Main verb (Past Participle)	Complement
I	haven't	seen	the rain.

Veja outros exemplos:

I **haven't seen** great movies lately.

You **haven't done** a pretty good job.

He **hasn't been** very busy.

She **hasn't traveled** all over the world.

It **hasn't worked** for me.

We **haven't lived** in different houses over the years.

You **haven't eaten** too much chocolate.

They **haven't bought** the Christmas presents.
